The rating given is as below:



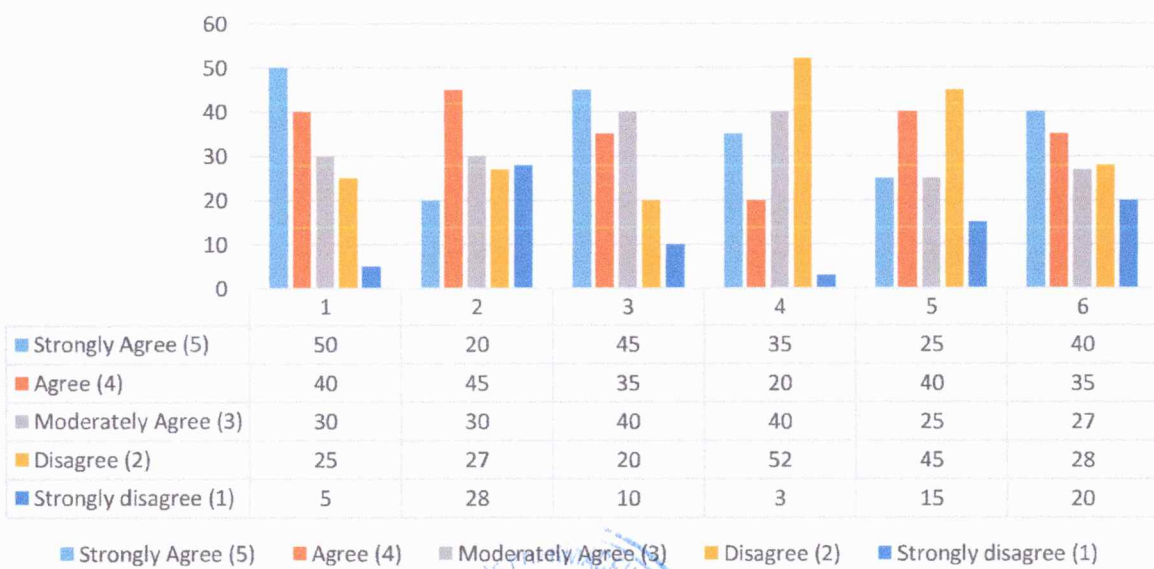

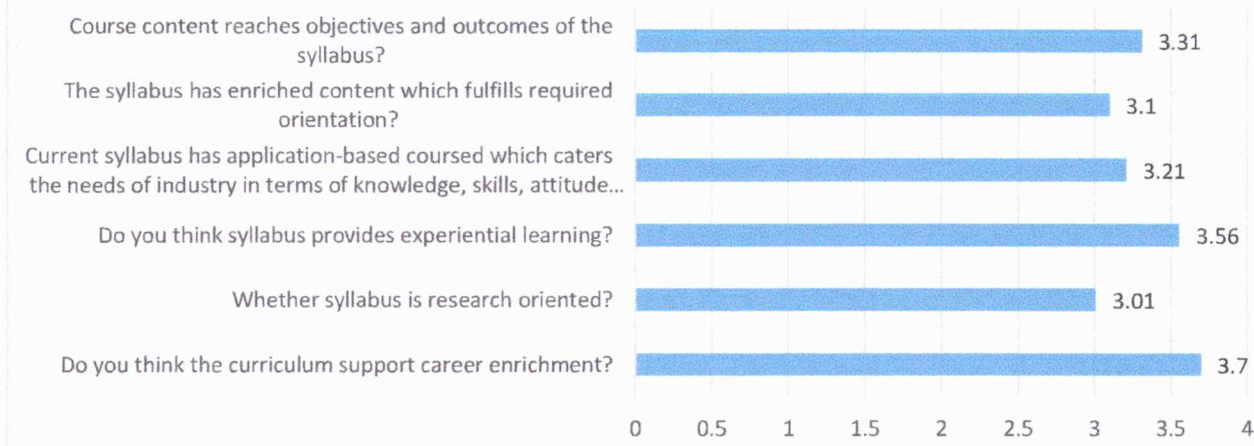
Analysis Feedback of Students on Curriculum

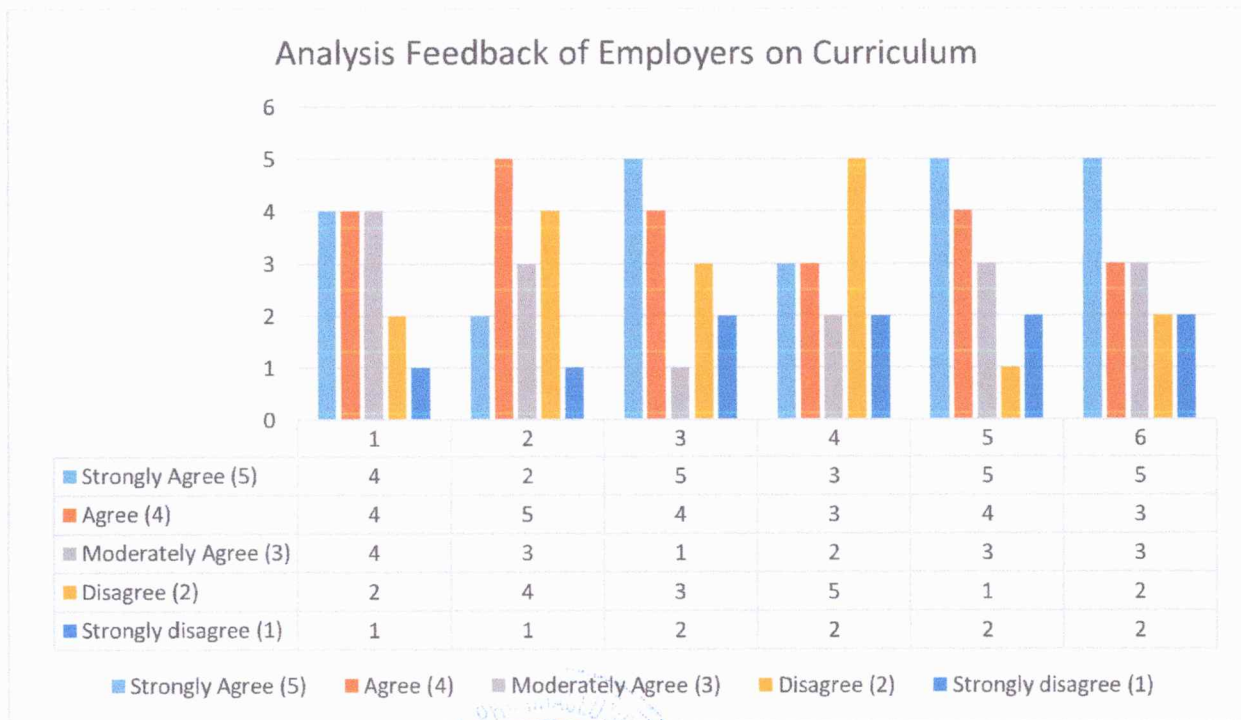
