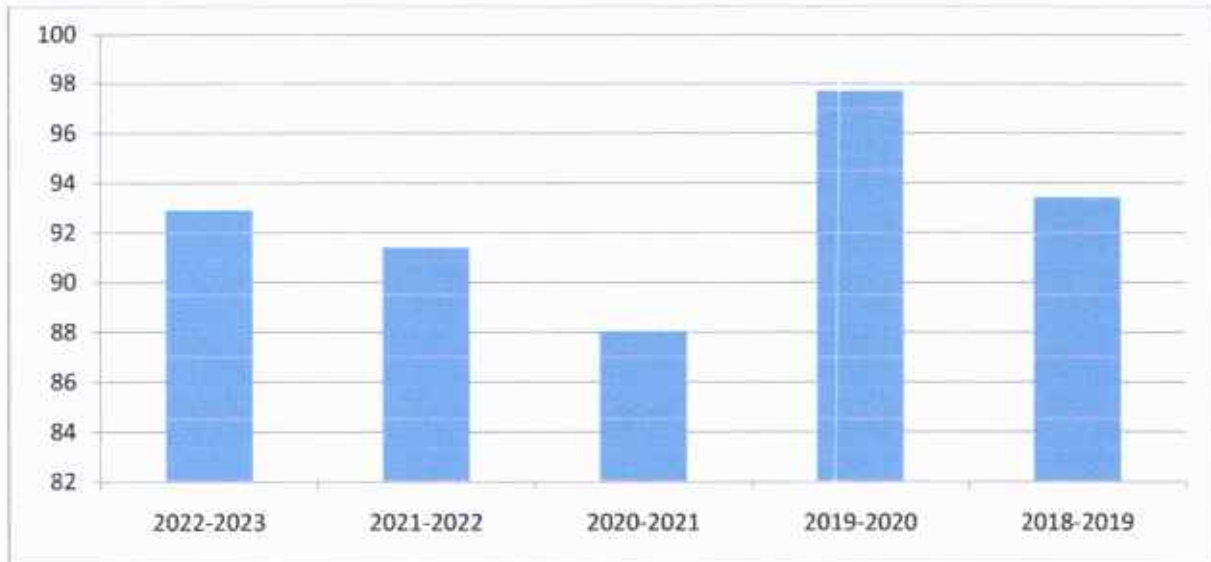

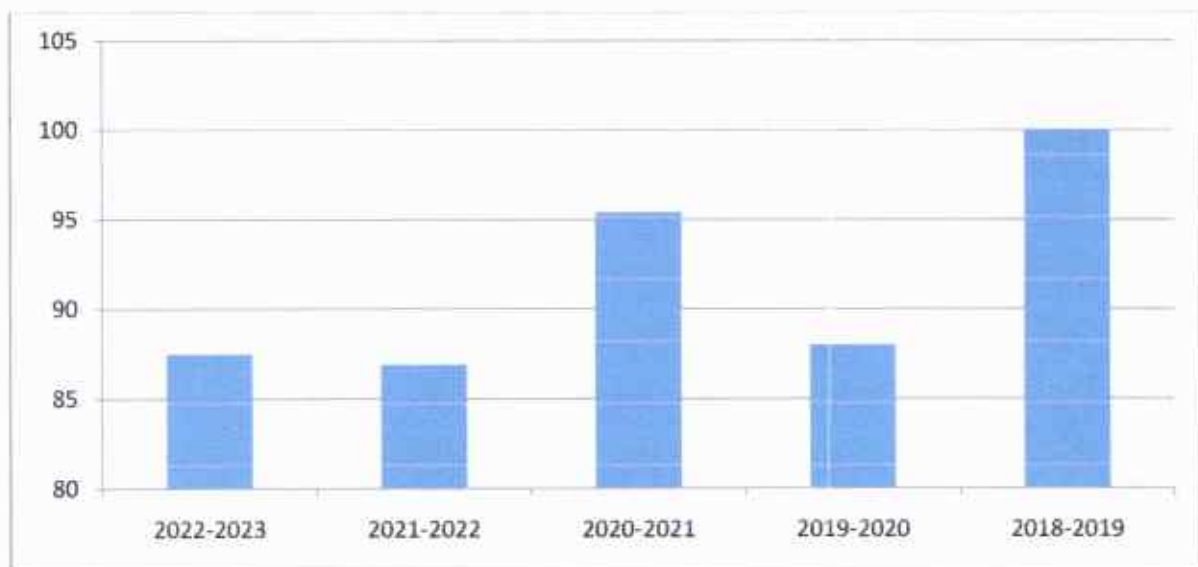

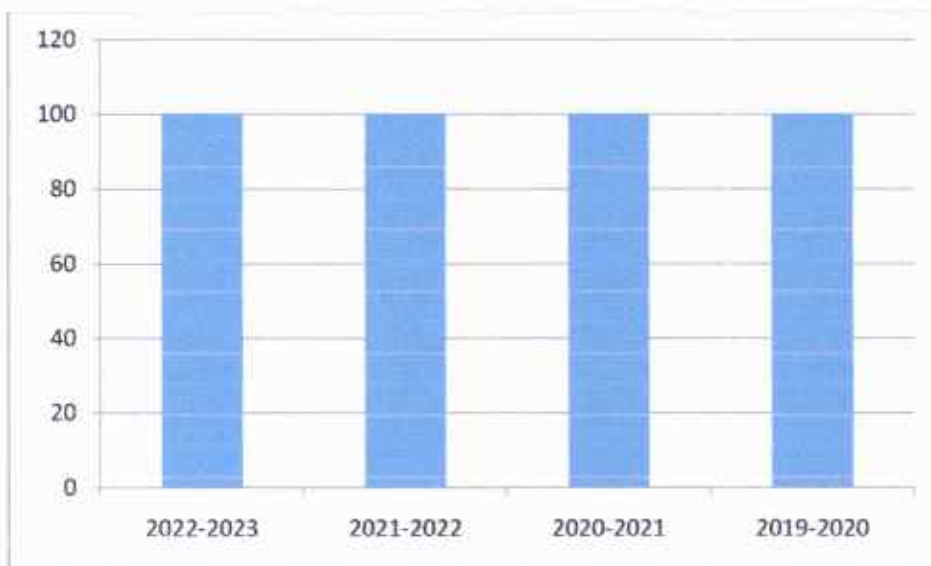

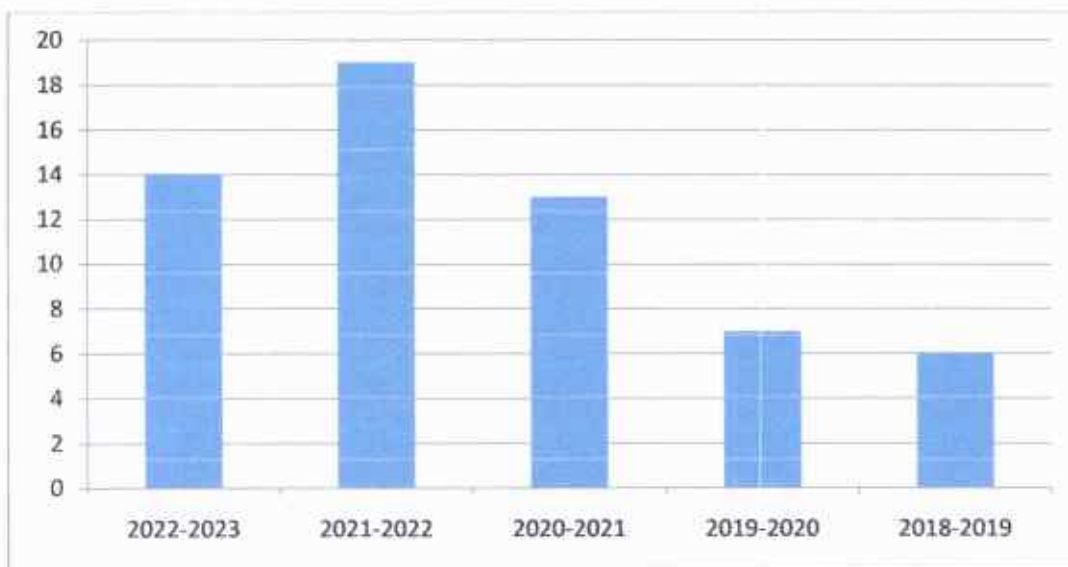

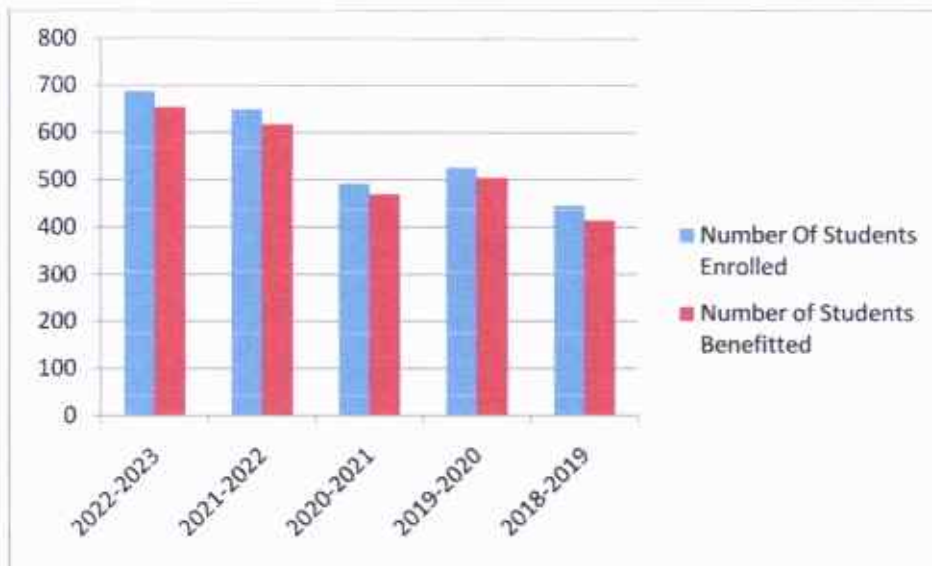

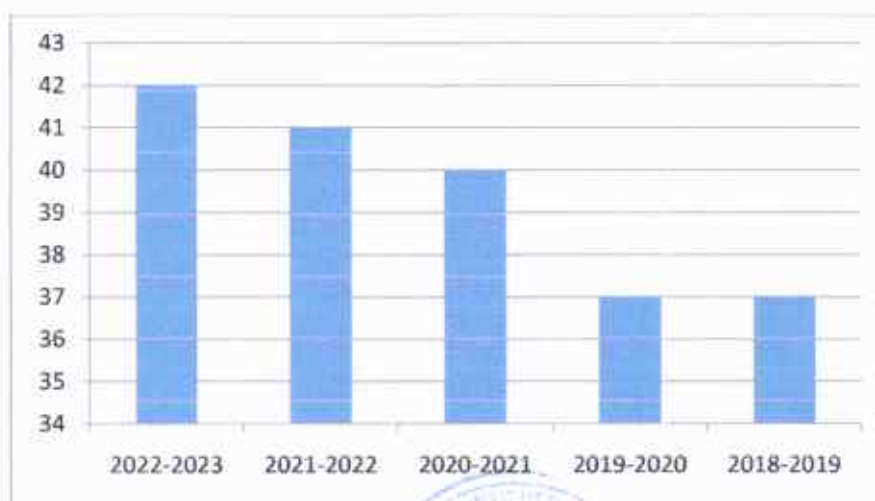


8. Faculty welfare Activities

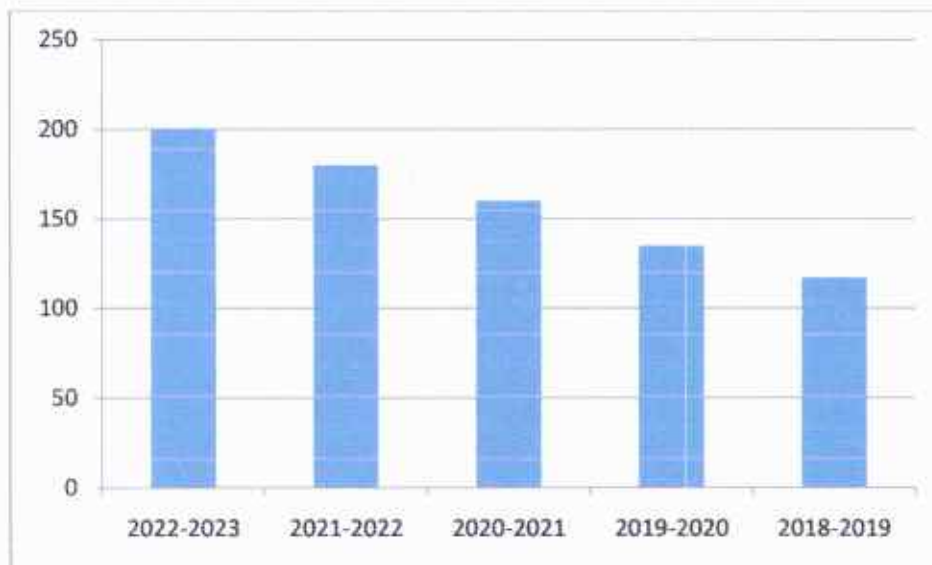

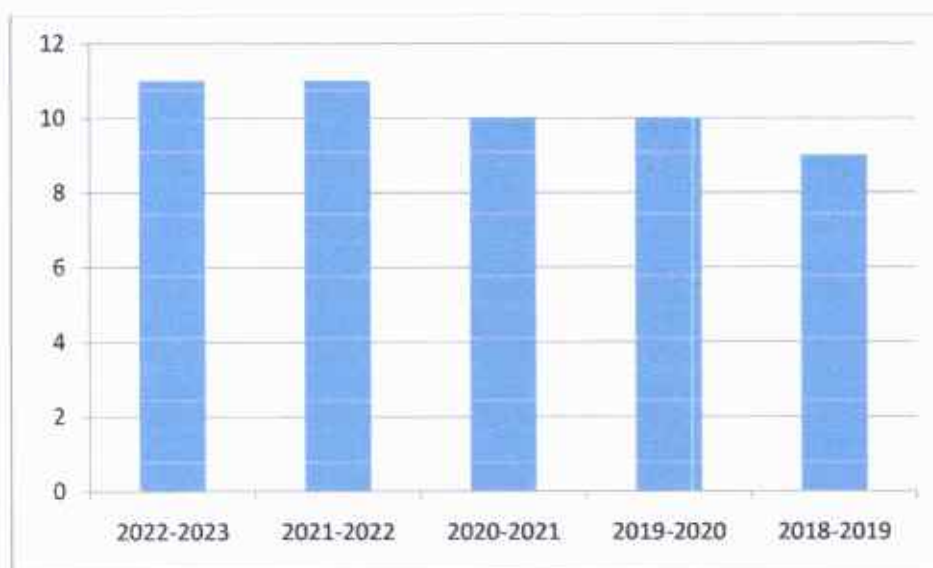
